About us

Heevie is an independent non-political, nonprofit organization specialized in providing various health care services especially for children, registered as a non-governmental organization in Kurdistan in 2005. Heevie works in a wide area of Iraq but mainly in Iraqi Kurdistan.

Due to the deliberate neglect by the Iraqi Central governments throughout the past decades, Kurdistan Region had suffered greatly over all facets of life (Health, Education, Basic services and Economics), that has resulted wide spread distribution of rare sicknesses and severe cases of dangerous diseases among its people. Wars and usage of prohibited chemical weapons had prompted serious types of diseases. Unfortunately, the incapable status of the health institutes at the time; it was almost impossible to deal with such sicknesses. Kurdistan Region still suffers from a lack of adequate infrastructure as a result of years of dictatorship and wars.

Heevie Organization, in cooperation with, and by the support of different international organizations and agencies such as the World Health Organization and Italian, German, Spanish and American organizations, has implemented a set of activities on the different health care levels, that involved, establishing and renovating healthcare facilities, training and capacity building of health service providers, providing the primary healthcare for the internally displaced people and refugees, providing mental health and psychosocial support services, providing physiotherapy and medical rehabilitation services, supporting health facilities, health centers and hospitals with medications, devices and medical supplies.

Heevie had taken the initiative to find a solution for the deteriorating health situation that sick children were going through by creating and developing medical projects to help treat children suffering from various diseases and to improve the pediatric treatment process and protocols in health establishments also through building a wide network of partners, volunteers, supporters to provide health services for the sick children by approaching and building tight relations with various Italian NGOs that are interested and specialized in such medical conditions.

The expertise brought by Italian physicians, the new health care methods, planning better according to scientific, economic and social basis, contributed greatly in improving local health operations. Training local health care personnel on the job in Kurdistan and during the missions is the revolutionary mark of Italian contribution as it had overcome lot of problems and brought back confidence to the local health care system. Blood banks, laboratories, pediatric section, emergency... etc are the beneficiaries of Italian expertise which eventually benefit the local community.


With the stabilization of the status in Iraq following years of wars, crises, instability and violence in the country, there are still large numbers of people who are vulnerable and in need of sustainable humanitarian support, this involves the people inhabiting various IDPs camps and those returned to their areas of origin. The needs and requirements of the people are distributed over multiple fields and sectors, from which the health and education are the most prominent in the camps where the Internally Displaced People are settled, while the areas of return needs are mainly renovating/ re-establishing the service provision facilities and guarantying the provision of the basic life support services mainly in the fields of health, education, water and sanitation, roads, and others fields.




Despite the plans of the related authorities to support the return process for the displaced people to their areas of origin, the IDPs populations of Duhok, Erbil, Sulaymaniyah and Ninewa governorate are still unable to return to their original places for various reasons, mainly the instability of the security situation and the obvious gaps in the service provision. With the start of the year 2023, and as a continuation of its efforts to provide the assistance and support for the vulnerable populations, Heevie organization continued implementing its different projects and activities aiming to respond to the needs and requirements of the different population groups mainly the IDPs, returnees and the host community in the different regions and governorates. Heevie activities has covered different levels of service provision involving the below categories:

- 1. Registering and treating patients with congenital heart diseases and chronic and difficult to be treated illnesses.
- 2. Providing primary health care services both through the static clinics and the mobile medical clinics
- 3. Providing mental health services and psychosocial support services
- 4. Providing the physiotherapy and medical rehabilitation services
- 5. Training and capability building of the health staff
- 6. Establishing, rehabilitation and renovation of health facilities
- 7. Providing medicines and medical supplies
- 8. Supporting local healthcare facilities

Heevie Organization has been able to provide equitable, safe and free access to healthcare services for tens of thousands of vulnerable and crises affected populations.





July 2023 data and achievements

During July 2023, Heevie organization implemented a total of 22 projects, with the activation of 12 health facilities, while the work continued to establish Galavezh Center Pediatrics Hemato-oncological Diseases in Duhok governorate and renovation of two hospitals (Erbil Maternity Hospital and Sulaymaniyah Burn and Plastic Surgery Hospital). During this month, **460** employees of various medical and non-medical professions, of both genders, worked within Heevie projects. The projects that were implemented during this month provided services to beneficiaries from the host community, IDPs, returnees, and refugees.

1. Project: Treating Patients and Training the Local Medical staff in cooperation with Italian organizations



Heevie program for treating the children suffering from congenital heart diseases is continuous since the year 2005. The main objective of the program is to provide the treatment opportunities for hundreds of patients suffering the congenital cardiac anomalies. The program involves, in a part of it, organizing regular missions for the Italian cardiac teams to perform multiple surgical operations in the local facilities.

Heevie organization is implementing an integrated program for treating the patients with congenital heart diseases through which the treatment opportunities are provided for hundreds of children from various Iraqi provinces suffering congenital heart defects. Surgical operations are not limited to those performed through the field visits of the Italian specialized medical teams to Kurdistan Region and Iraq, but extended to coordinate transfer of patients to Italy, where delicate and complex operations are performed for many patients in the specialized hospitals and centres of various Italian cities.






This program is implemented with the support of the health office of His Excellency the President of KRI Mr. Nechirvan Barzani. During this month, **Two** patients were sent to Italy to perform surgery.

2. Project: Registering and examining the Children with Congenital Heart Diseases Heevie Organization continued working on its program of documenting the details and information of the patients with congenital heart defects, in an effort to make them ready and available when any treatment or surgical intervention opportunity is available. This activity is continuous since the year 2001, and earlier during the implementation, the management process was coordinated with the cardiac centers in Kurdistan Region and Baghdad, to which the patients were sent regularly for assessment, evaluation and intervention. Through this program, an integrated database was created for patients with congenital heart defects in Kurdistan Region and Iraq, and it had a significant impact on the health status of the

During the last eighteen years of implementation, the total number of patients with congenital heart diseases recorded in Heevie database reached 10,848 patients, 1,530 of whom died due to lack of the treatment opportunities. The total number of surgical operations performed by the Italian medical teams for the congenital heart anomalies during their visits to Kurdistan Region and the children transferred to Italy to receive treatment and surgical interventions there reached 822 operations.

During July 2023, Heevie registered (27) new cases of children with congenital heart disease in its database. The project is being implemented by Heevie Health NGO in coordination with the Directorates of Health in the different Governorates and SIA Italian Organization.

Providing primary health care services through the static clinics overview



Heevie support for the health system covered responding to the needs on the different healthcare levels, involving the primary, secondary and tertiary levels. The primary healthcare services are an integral component of the health system, being the first line health service provider that ensures people receive quality comprehensive care, covering the promotion and prevention services to the treatment and rehabilitation care.


Heevie Organization continued supporting the provision of the primary healthcare services to the vulnerable population from host community, IDPs and refugees throughout different governorates. This has been done through running the static primary healthcare centers and the mobile medical clinics, according to the needs and requirements of the targeted population, and also the overall situation in the targeted areas in regard to the access, security and the availability of the health facilities and services.

As a part of its current package of projects, Heevie organization provides the primary health care services in nine IDPs camps in Duhok, Erbil, Sulaymaniyah and Ninewa Governorates, in addition to supporting one subdistrict PHCC. The camp clinics supported are those of Shariya, Kabarto2, Rwanga, Bajed Kandala, Chameshku, Bersivy1, Bersivy2, Essiyan, Mam Rash, Hasan Sham U2 and Ashti IDPs camps

The services provided involved the below mentioned services:

- 1. Specialize medical and general practitioner consultations
- 2. Management of communicable and non-communicable diseases
- 3. Reproductive healthcare services (antenatal care, postnatal care and family planning consultations).
- 4. Mental Health and Psychosocial support services
- 5. Health education and awareness
- 6. Medical laboratory services.
- Referral services for advanced (secondary, tertiary/life-saving) medical interventions.
- 8. Immunization services specially for under 5-yearold children
- 9. Nutritional and growth monitoring services
- 10.Ultrasound examination and dental care services (in selected locations)



3. Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Mam Rash IDPs camp in Ninawa governorate

Mam Rash IDPs camp is located in Sheikhan district of Ninewa governorate, it has the capacity of hosting around 10,000 people while its current population is 7,798 people who are all from those displaced from Sinjar district of Ninewa governorate. Since the year 2015, and when it was first established, Heevie organization has continued the health care service provision within its static clinic in Mam Rash IDPs which represent a complete response to the needs of its residents at the primary health care level, involving medical consultation, treatment of communicable and non-communicable diseases, reproductive health care services, health awareness, psychosocial support, growth monitoring and evaluation, vaccination, disease surveillance and control and referral to the higher level health facilities, all free of charge.

The staff working within Heevie healthcare center in Mam Rash camp are distributed over the medical and no-medical staff involving doctors, nurses, assistant pharmacists, laboratory assistants, community health workers, social works, patient registration and clerking staff, and admin and logistician staff. During March2023, the service provision through Heevie PHCC in Mam Rash camp continued.



4. Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Shariya IDPs camp in Duhok governorate.

Shariya camp is among the camps that were established during the year 2014 with the start of the huge waves of displacement of the population to Duhok governorate, it is considered among the largest camps in terms of area and population density, with a capacity to host around 18,000 people, while the current population is nearly 13,000 people.

In continuation of its programs to serve the IDPs in Duhok governorate, Heevie organization is running the primary health care center in Shariya camp, providing the full package of primary health care and mental health and psychosocial support services in addition to the reproductive health services, ultrasound examination, oral and dental hygiene, and the medical laboratory examinations.

Heevie has recruited health staff from different specializations in order to work within its clinic in Shariya camp, aiming order to respond to the maximum needs of the population, this included internal medicine, pediatrics, general surgery and gynecology and obstetrics specialties, a step that on one hand reduced the patient referral to higher health levels, minimizing the burden on those facilities, and on the other hand decreased the economic, psychological and social impact of the residents of the camp



5. Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Bersivy1 IDPs camp in Duhok governorate.

Among the camps that Heevie organization covers with health activities is Bersivy1 IDPs camp in Zakho district, which hosts thousands of families displaced from Sinjar district early during the war against the ISIS terroristic group in 2014. Heevie provides the full package of primary health care services in the camp, that has the capacity of hosting 11,000 people and is currently hosting around 4,890 people.

The services provided are both on the curative and preventive levels, involving the specialist doctor consultation, mental health and psychosocial support, health awareness and education, growth monitoring and evaluation, reproductive health care services, vaccinations and advanced medical laboratory services. Heevie PHC in the camp is active 24 hourly, 7 days a week, with the aim of responding to the maximum needs of the camp residents. This is done through experienced staff who are running the different departments and branches of the facilitates involving the consultation rooms, the female and male dressing room, the laboratory unit, pharmacy and store, the patient admission and isolation departments



6. Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Kabarto2 IDPs camp in Duhok governorate

Kabarto2 IDPs camp, located in Semel district of Duhok governorate and is hosting about 13,000 people, is one of the IDPs camps in Duhok Governorate that got benefit from the health services provided by Heevie Organization. The camp population are all from the people displaced from Sinjar district of Ninewa Governorate after the wars and crises in their regions.

Heevie health facility in Kabarto2 camp is consisted of several units and departments such as the male and female patients' consultations rooms, dressing rooms for both genders, nutrition room, psychosocial support department, medical laboratory unit, pharmacy and store, patient admission and stabilization and patient isolation room. The services provided by Heevie clinic are free of charge and available 24 hourly including the treatment of communicable and non-communicable diseases, healthcare services, reproductive nutrition, vaccinations, health promotion and awareness, mental health psychosocial support and medical laboratory services







7. Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Rwanga IDPs camp in Duhok governorate

Rwanga IDPs camp is among the various camps in Duhok governorate which were established since the beginning of the displacement of the population from the crises affected areas in the different regions throughout Iraq during the war against ISIS terroristic group. The camp hosts thousands of displaced people fleeing the scourge of wars and disasters that followed ISIS occupation of large areas of Ninewa Governorate, most of whom are from the Yezidi population.

Heevie organization provides the primary healthcare services in Rwanga camp aiming to respond to the health needs of its population through Heevie primary health care center in the camp, which is active around the clock and is equipped and provided with a specialized and well trained staff to provide health services.

The services provided include curative and preventive services involving the treatment of communicable and non-communicable diseases, reproductive healthcare services, nutrition and growth monitoring, vaccinations services, health promotion and awareness, mental health psychosocial support and medical laboratory services.



8. Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Chameshku IDPs camp in Duhok governorate

Chameshko IDPs camp in Zakho district is considered the largest camp for internally displaced people in the whole Dohuk governorate. As a part of its efforts to respond to the different health needs of the camp populations, Heevie organization expanded its activities in the camp through activating and supporting the primary health care center within the camp, to be added to the services already provided through the Heevie / Farmamundi Specialized Health Center.

Heevie PHCC at Chameshko camp provides the full package of primary health care services, including medical consultations, mental health and psychological support services, health awareness and education, medical laboratory, preventive health services such as vaccination, and the referral services to the higher healthcare facilities. These are added to reproductive healthcare services, growth monitoring and vaccination services, which are carried out in cooperation with the Preventive Health Department in the Directorate of Health in Zakho district.

The medical activities of Heevie organization in Chameshko camp have led to a marked improvement in the level of healthcare services in the camp, especially the previously the center provided specific services being active few hours a day only, lacking many of the basic health needs of the beneficiaries



As part of its attempts to provide and sustain the various healthcare services to the displaced people in the different camps within Dohuk governorate, Heevie Organization is providing the primary health care services to the residents of the Bajed Kendala1 IDPs camp in the Semel district of Duhok governorate, through Heevie healthcare center in the camp. The camp is inhabited by around 8,000 people who are all from Sinjar District of Ninewa governorate and are unable to return back to their areas of origin due to multiple reasons being mainly due to security instability and the non-readiness of the service provision infrastructure.

The services provided includes medical consultations, reproductive health services, psychological support services, health awareness and education, medical laboratory services, chronic and acute medications prescription and preventive health services. This is done through the available staff from doctors, nurses, assistant pharmacists, laboratory assistants, community health workers, social works and patient registration and admin staff.



The camp locations covered with Heevie activities and support are distributed over Duhok, Erbil, Ninewa and Sulaymaniyah Governorates. 





In a continuation for the efforts made by Heevie Organization to provide the best healthcare services to the IDPs in the different camp and none camp locations, and in the framework of the constant quest to fill the gaps in these services in various locations, Heevie, in cooperation with Farmamundi Spanish organization, continued providing quality health care services in Chameshko IDPs Camp in Zakho District, Dohuk Governorate. These services are provided through a specialized center established by Heevie Organization in the camp and consists of doctors' consultation room, ultrasound examination room, male and female dressing rooms, pharmacy and store, laboratory unit and dental chair and oral hygiene department. Chameshku camp is currently hosting nearly 23,000 people who are from the people displaced from Sinjar district in Ninewa governorate. Heevie center is providing the planned health services 24 hourly, free of charge, by the Heevie Organization in coordination with Farmamundi Spanish Organization and by the support of Generalitat Valenciana GVA from Spain. The services provided involve treatment of communicable and non-communicable diseases, reproductive healthcare services, nutrition and growth monitoring, vaccinations services, health promotion and awareness, mental health psychosocial support and medical laboratory services, addwd to the specialized mental health and psychosocial support activities that are done through the psychiatrist doctor and providing the specific medication needed as a treatment for the psychiatric conditions.



14. Project: Primary health care services within Heevie static clinic in Dawodiya IDPs camp in Duhok governorate

Dawodiya IDPs camp is one of the camps established during the period of the war against ISIS as a shelter for the people displaced from the crises affected regions, mainly Sinjar District of Ninewa Governorate. The camp is located in Bamerni sub-district of Duhok governorate and has the capacity of hosting more than 5,000 people, it has shown fluctuation in its population in the last period to be finally settled with around 2,500 people.

In an effort to provide healthcare services for Dawodiya camp population, Heevie Organization, and through running its Primary Healthcare Center in the camp, is providing the medical consultations for the camp population, in addition to the treatment of non-communicable communicable and diseases. reproductive health care services, medical laboratory tests, male and female dressing and nursing care and referring the patients in need for more advanced services to the higher level facilities. To be mentioned that in addition to the camp population, the people living the villages surrounding the camp get benefit from the services provided within the facility.


The project is implemented by Heevie organization and funded together by both Heevie and Medical Aid Initiative Norway Organization from Norway.



15. Project: Reproductive Health Care Services within Heevie projects

As part of the attention paid to the women's health within its projects, specifically pregnant ladies and the women of childbearing age, Heevie organization provides reproductive health services in all its health centers on a regular basis and through an efficient staff from doctors and nurses. These services include prenatal care, postnatal care and family planning services, and extends to include also the screening for breast cancer, education and promotion on breastfeeding as well providing the pregnant ladies and the breast feeding mothers with the necessary medications and drugs. In order to provide the necessary tools for making the program successful, Heevie dedicated part of the support provided for the laboratory and pharmacy departments for the purpose of providing the necessary tests and medications for the patients got benefit from the program, added to the ultrasound examination, which were of paramount importance for pregnant women and at all stages of pregnancy. The reproductive healthcare activities are implemented with a direct support of Heevie organization in many of the facilities run by Heevie, and in cooperation with other partners in other facilities.



16. Project: Health promotion/ education within Heevie projects in Camps (Shariya, Mam rash, Bersivy 1, Kabarto 2, Ashti, Rwanga, Cham Mishko, Bajid Kandala, Essian, Bersivy 2) and Bozan sub district

The health education and promotion activities have become an important element of any health care programs, due to their great importance in the preventive and curative fields, which has further increased with the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic and the increasing risks on the individual and public health as a result of the epidemics of the communicable diseases, especially during the war and crisis. The importance of health awareness programs extends to integrating into the daily life of every person, especially those who are vulnerable such as the women, elderly people, children and the patients with special needs.

Heevie organization provides an integrated program for the health awareness and promotion, as this is done through daily activities that are implemented by community health workers in a scientific manner according to pre-established schedules that are distributed over the different locations taking in consideration the health situation of the targeted population, the risk of the communicable diseases and the global calendar of the health events.

The health awareness activities involve providing the health awareness sessions to visitors of health centers directly, whether through individual or group sessions, performing tent-to-tent and household visits to deliver health messages to the beneficiaries, informing them of the services in the health center, and also referring the cases that need specific services to the health center and coordination and visits to community centers and schools to deliver the health messages

17. Project: Providing access to the mental and psychosocial support services for the vulnerable populations

For the third successive year, Heevie organization continues the activities of its project to provide the mental health and psychological support services for the vulnerable populations from IDPs through its specialized centers in eight IDPs camps, which are provided with the experienced staff from psychiatrist doctors, psychologists and social workers, from both genders. This is done taking into account the high numbers of mental health cases and the increasing numbers of suicide in the camps, making the availability of such specialized centers to provide the necessary support in this regard one of the basic requirements for any health intervention program targeting the IDPs and the other vulnerable population.

Heevie MHPSS centers in the targeted IDPs camps are active six days per week and the treatment provided includes the psychotherapy, psychological support, social support and medical therapy. The duties and responsibilities of the project staff working within the centers are organized in a way allowing a smooth work flow and more effective case detection and management. As part of this process, the social workers perform tent-to-tent visits, they visit community and social centers and schools in the camp in order to pick up the suspected cases and then refer them to the MHPSS centers, where they are received by psychotherapists who organize and sort them to choose the cases that need the intervention of the specialist psychiatrists' doctor



Heevie activities of providing the mental health services and psychosocial support is implemented with the support of the World Health Organization and includes eight camps, which are Shariya, Kabarto2, Rwanga, Bersivy1, Bersivy2, Bajed Kandala, Mam Rash and Chameshko camps, added to Essian and Ashti camps in which only the psychosocial support services are provided

As part of the full package of health care services provided by Heevie, the psychosocial support and mental health care services are among the core services that the organization has engaged in its plan to respond to the health needs and requirements of the crises-affected population. In addition to managing the specialized centers in this field, Heevie has incorporated these services into all the primary health care centers it runs in the various camps.

18. Building the clinical capacities and skills of medical staff working in the health facilities

The training and capacity building of the health staff is considered of the most important activities implemented by Heevie Organization. It aims to prepare a qualified medical staff so that they will be able to deal with patients in an optimal manner, leading to an obvious improvement of the healthcare services provided within the various health facilities.

In this field, Heevie Organization is implementing an integrated project to train the medical staff working within its projects and centers, which is done through including them in strengthening courses that covers various medical topics, especially those that are encountered in important medical departments and institutions. This project is implemented by Heevie with the support of the World Health Organization in a way allowing the availability of the trainers in the field to come in a direct contact with the medical staff in the different project locations and provided both the theoretical trainings and materials and also the practical implementation of the different tasks and activities.

The medical topics provided with the training courses are selected according to the needs, requirements and gaps aiming to build the capacity of the health staff working on the different healthcare levels, mainly the primary one. The staff planned to be trained are the medical doctors, male and female nurses, assistant pharmacists, laboratory assistants and community health workers.




Gender Breakdown

19. Project: Providing the Physical Rehabilitation Services and supporting people with special needs

Among the set of services provided by Heevie Organization for the vulnerable population are the services provided for the disabled people and those with special needs. In this field, Heevie is providing the physiotherapy and medical rehabilitation services through Heevie physiotherapy and medical rehabilitation center in Duhok Governorate. The center is provided with a specialized staff of doctors, physiotherapists, nurses and other staff and involves patient registration unit, data entry and analysis, medical consultation unit, physical rehabilitation halls, massage and laser therapy, dressing room, administration and management unit.

Added to the basic rehabilitation services provided, Heevie rehabilitation center provides supportive devices for people with disability, such as wheelchairs, crutches, sticks and other supportive devices, additional, the care and support is provided for the people with special needs such as the blind people and those with visual impairment through conducting a special training program and providing their special needs and requirements.





20. Establishing Galavezh Center for Pediatrics Hemato-oncological Diseases in Duhok Gover





The data and statistics of the pediatrics hematological and oncological diseases are recording high rates in Duhok governorate and the region due to different reasons, such a high number of patients are in need for a specialized center to provide the necessary medical management on a scientific basis.

In an effort to provide the optimum environment for the patients with Haemato-oncological diseases, Heevie is implementing a project for establishing a specialized center for treating these diseases, which is Galavezh specialized Center for Pediatrics Haemato-oncological diseases in Dohuk governorate, a project that is implemented directly by the engineering department of Heevie Organization within the geographic area of Heevi pediatrics hospital, which the main secondary/ tertiary pediatrics facility in the whole Duhok Governorate.

The new center will play an important role in improving the services provided to children suffering from hemato-oncological diseases. The project designs and maps with the complete plan for the work flow and service provision are coordinated with the Italian partners, and specifically SIA Organization and Biomedical Technology Consulting company. The final designs and maps of the new facility have been developed taking in consideration the special needs and requirements of the patients suffering from hematological and oncological diseases in terms of infection control, allocating special isolation rooms for the critical patients, inpatients wards, units for the daily treatment, unit for preparation of chemotherapy, medical procedures room and a pharmacy.

The center will be built according to the latest medical engineering systems, taking into account adopting the highest quality materials and tools and is aiming to play an important role in improving the services provided to children suffering from oncological, malignancies and hematological diseases. In order to better develop the designs of the new center to respond to the maximum needs of the patients, serial meetings are hold between Heevie Organization, the Directorate of Health in Duhok and Heevi teaching hospital at attended by people in charge in the mentioned authorities.



Galavezh center for pediatrics hemato-oncological disease will provide the specialized care and services for hundreds of oncological cases, more than 1,000 Thalassemia and Sickle Cell Anemia cases and 175 cases of factor deficiencies patients, mainly Hemophilia

21. Renovation of Adult Burn Unit, Critical Department, Trauma Department and Construction of Physiotherapy hall in Sulaymaniyah Burn and Plastic Surgery Hospital



The health facilities in Sulaymaniyah governorate are under huge pressure resulting from the increasing numbers of population and beneficiaries, as in addition to the host community, they are providing services to the IDPs and refugees as well, in addition to the big financial crises in KRI and Iraq as a whole, an issue that limits the ability of these facilities to respond to the needs of the beneficiaries and accommodate with the situation.

Sulaymaniyah Burn and Plastic Surgery Hospital is one of the oldest hospitals in Sulaymaniyah, established more than 90 years ago. It is providing services for different victims of a wide range of accident burns in addition to performing plastic and reconstructive surgical interventions for patients with congenital and acquired deformities and malformations. The increasing load and pressure on the facility from the growing needs of the beneficiaries, in addition to the exhausted facility building, make it obligatory to improve the service provision in the hospital by supporting the different branches and departments in the hospital.

As a continuation of the efforts to support Sulaymaniyah Burn and Plastic Surgery Hospital, Heevie Organization, with the support of WHO, has started a project for performing renovation of the hospital through performing renovation of Adult Burn Unit, Critical Department, Trauma Department and Construction of Physiotherapy hall. The project is implementing by the engineering department of Heevie Organization with the support of World Health Organization. To be mentioned that this project is considered the third phase of the rehabilitation process of Sulaymaniyah Burn and Plastic Surgery Hospital, implemented by Heevie Organization with the support of the World Health Organization.

This phase includes the renovation of three departments: that are the adult burn unit, the trauma department and the critical care unit. The first phase included renovation and extension of the Surgical operations. Halls, while the second one involved the rehabilitation of the pediatrics burn unit, the outpatient department, the consultation room, reception department, the laboratory, the pharmacy and Warehouse department. A special ceremony attended by His Excellency the Consul of the United States of America at Erbil and Dr. Ahmed Zueiten, World Health Organization Representative in Iraq and Dr. Haval Abu Bakr Governor of Sulaymaniyah and Dr. Sabah Hawrami Director General of Health in Sulaymaniyah Governorate, to inaugurate the departments that were expanded and renovated in Sulaymaniyah Burns and Plastic Surgery Hospital. The project was implemented by the engineering department of Heevie Organization with the support of World Health Organization during which Heevie used the most updated medical standards and the high-quality materials.



















22. Renovation of the Delivery Unit, Postpartum Unit and High Risk Unit in Erbil Maternity Hospital



The World Health Organization in Iraq is currently undertaking a significant project at the maternity hospital in Erbil implemented by Heevie Health NGO. This project represents the second phase of the WHO initiative in the hospital, with the aim of creating a welcoming environment for mothers, newborns, and their families, while addressing their physical and emotional needs. The overall objective is to ensure that the hospital meets the highest standards of care and aligns with the WHO's commitment to promoting maternal and newborn health. The project, which involves expanding three units and adding 546 square meters, began in April of 2023 and is expected to conclude in late December 2023. It encompasses several key interventions to enhance the functionality and capacity of the units: The High-Risk Pregnancy area: This unit specializes in admitting women with pregnancy complications related to various diseases. Initially, the unit had a capacity of 14 beds. As part of the project, an additional 6-bed area will be added, increasing the total capacity to 20 beds. This expansion is expected to significantly reduce perinatal morbidity and mortality rates.

Additionally, several new facilities will be introduced, including resting rooms for medical staff, changing rooms for female and male staff, a resuscitation room, a spacious reception area, and staff and patient bathrooms, which are currently lacking. The Delivery Unit: The delivery unit consists of two sections: one for the first stage of delivery (labor) and another for the second stage of delivery (birth). Currently, the unit has a total bed capacity of 17. As part of the project, 7 additional beds will be added, increasing the capacity to 24 beds. Furthermore, new facilities will be introduced, such as an isolation room for cases requiring isolation (which currently does not exist), an examination room, a resting room, a cold kitchen for on-call staff, and additional bathrooms. The Postpartum Unit: Currently, the postpartum unit has a capacity of 14 beds. As part of the project, an additional 4 beds will be incorporated, increasing the total capacity to 18 beds. The unit will be thoughtfully designed, featuring individual cabinets to ensure a standardized bed capacity, along with its dedicated bathrooms. Furthermore, the units will be interconnected to facilitate a seamless flow of patients, emphasizing the importance of the "Golden Hours" and supporting infection prevention and control measures. To enhance air quality and circulation within the units, central ventilation, a Fresh Air System, and Ducted Split systems will be installed. These interventions are aimed at enhancing the overall care provided at the maternity hospital in Erbil. By expanding the units, introducing necessary facilities, and improving the flow and infection control measures, the hospital will be better equipped to provide comprehensive and high-quality care to mothers, newborns, and their families, promoting their well-being and safety.

To be mentioned that this project is considered the second phase of the rehabilitation process of the Renovation of Erbil Maternity Hospital implemented by Heevie Organization with the support of the World Health Organization. Phase one included expanding the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, taking into account the latest scientific and medical updates in this field in terms of medical care provided to these babies, as well as sterilization and infection control methods adopted in such sensitive sections added to expanding the department establishing services that did not exist before. The project also included the renovation of the emergency operation theatre in the maternity hospital to make it qualified to accommodate the increasing number of patients. The project is being implemented directly by Heevie engineering department with the support of the World Health Organization.
