Other Activities in 2022

• COVID-19 Awareness and prevention activities

Along with the current situation in the region regarding the risk of Covid-19 infection and due to the important role of protection systems in preventing this highly contagious disease, Heevie organization has started implementing strict regulations in all of its projects in order to help protect employees and beneficiaries from infection. This was done through the following activities:

- 1- Providing personal protective equipment for employees working in all static and mobile clinics. These materials included face masks, gowns, gloves and other requirements, in addition to disinfectants and sterilization materials.
- 2- Complete sterilization of all health facilities with regular provision of sterilization and cleaning solutions and supplies, in order to carry out regular cleaning work on a daily basis.
- 3- Organizing training courses for staff working within the organization's projects in order to orient them about Covid-19 pandemic and its prevention, as well as dealing with the current situation and applying the basic rules in their daily work and activities related to disease prevention.
- 4- Directing all health education and awareness staff in the different camps to focus on raising awareness about the prevention of Covid-19 disease by providing regular sessions for visitors of the health centers, as well as through the household and tent to tent visits to reach the largest possible number of beneficiaries.

• Heevie organization starts its project to expand and renovate two advanced health facilities in Erbil Governorate

In the presence of Dr. Wael Hatahet, WHO Emergency Team Lead in Iraq, Dr. Dilovan Mohammed Fateh, Director General of Directorate of Health in Erbil Governorate, and Dr. Mohammed Mahmod, the Projects Manager at Heevie Organization, an expanded meeting was held in the meeting hall of the Directorate of Health in Erbil Governorate, which was devoted to highlighting the broad outlines of two projects that Heevie Organization is implementing in Erbil, one of which involves expanding the patient reception hall in East Erbil Emergency Hospital in a way making it capable of accommodating the huge pressure resulted from the big load of patients visiting the facility.

While the other project includes expanding the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit of Erbil Maternity Hospital, in addition to the renovation of the emergency surgical halls in the hospital.

The project will be implemented directly by the engineering department of Heevie with the support of the World Health Organization.

• Fire accident at Bajed Kandala1 IDPs camp in Duhok Governorate

On Thursday June 30th 2022, at 11:00 a.m., a fire accident took place at Bajed Kandala 1 camp, and specifically at section B of the camp. The fire has led to destruction of almost 22 tents, which were habited by 49 families and 266 individuals, according to the camp management.

Immediately after the accident, Heevie Organization, and through its health facility in the camp, which is supported by WHO, took the necessary actions in order to treat any possible casualties, these actions involved:

- 1. Preparedness steps on the health facility level through preparation of the patients' beds, the oxygen sources, the oxygen cylinders and the medical supplies and consumables.
- 2. Allocating a mobile medical team in the field in order to provide the first aid for the injured people, if any, and refer them to Heevie health facility in the camp. The team was provided with an ambulance vehicle to facilitate the patient transportation.
- 3. Put the full capacity PHC with all the resources and staff in service in order to deal with any sudden flow of patients in the best way
- 4. Getting benefit from Heevie health facility at the nearby Rwanga camp, especially the ambulance vehicle for patient referral and transportation and also from the available oxygen cylinders and medical supplies.
- 5. Heevie MHPSS team was available in the field and at the PHCC in order to deal with the cases suffered psychological problems after the accident.

Below is a brief about the data of the patients received and managed at the day of the fire accident:

Total number of patients treated 45 cases, breakdown as follows:

- Number of cases with burn injuries (minor): 2 cases
- Number of patients with smoke inhalation and suffocation: 28 cases
- Number of cases with psychological trauma and hysteria: 15 cases

No cases needed referral for the higher healthcare facilities

Fortunately, no cases of deaths or severe burns were recorded
